

Inauguration of the Daher Learning Center: A new era for aeronautical talent development

The center can host up to 40 learners simultaneously, offering customized training for such technical professions as systems mechanics, assembly fitters, and cabin integrators. The programs range from short modules (1-3 days) to career transition courses lasting 1-3 months.

Since the 2000s, Daher has made skills acquisition and transmission a key driver for both its employees and clients. With this new center, Daher's goal is to address the shortage of technical skills while reinforcing its leadership in industrial services.

In 2024, nearly 700 learners were trained, with a target of 1,300 trainees for 2025, supported by this new infrastructure.
